

January 2023 Reminder: Final Call for Papers and Information ISASI 2023 Seminar

Nashville, Tennessee: Renaissance Nashville Hotel
August 21, 2023 – August 25, 2023
The 2023 Theme is "Accidents: The Current Which Lies Beneath"

This will be an "in-person" event with tutorials on Monday the 21st, the seminar presentations will be made from Tuesday the 22nd through Thursday the 24th. There will also be various evening get-togethers during the week.

THE THEME: "Accidents: The Current Which Lies Beneath" Addresses the component of not what caused the event but the "WHY" the error occurred. These insidious sub-surface factors, that may be multiple, go unnoticed and can be cumulative. Their influence creates an impediment to a successful outcome that even experienced crews and pilots have challenges overcoming.

Papers are therefore broad and span training, operations, human interaction, material failure, creative processes of examination, new investigative techniques, maintenance, physiological factors, and other subjects. Papers must be in English and support a presentation of 25 minutes followed by a five-minute session for questions. Finally, papers may exemplify either positive or negative outcomes, as both serve to make ISASI members better stewards of aviation investigative processes.

length, format, slide requirements, and other items.

MAY 26th: The DRAFT Papers, including a refined abstract, is due.

JUNE 30th: FINAL PAPERS and a DRAFT PowerPoint presentation is due.
